LEGAL NOTICE - ANNUAL ELECTION TOWN OF BROWNVILLE JOINT FIRE DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Annual Election of the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District will take place on December 10th, 2024, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District Station #1, 100 Locke St., Dexter, N.Y. for the purposes of electing the following Fire District Officer:

One Fire Commissioner for a five (5) year term, commencing January 1, 2025, and ending December 31st, 2029.

All candidates for a District Office shall be residents of the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District and not convicted of any degree of arson. Persons seeking office must file a petition signed by not less than twenty-five (25) qualified voters of the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District stating the position and term they are seeking with the Secretary of the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District, by mail at P.O. Box 2, Brownville, N.Y. 13615 or in person with the Fire District Secretary at the offices of the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District, 100 Locke St., Dexter, N.Y. Petition forms are available from the Secretary of the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District, 100 Locke St., Dexter, N.Y. Such petition must be filed with the Fire District Secretary on or before November 20th, 2024, by 12:30 p.m.

Any elector of the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District who shall be a registered voter with the Jefferson County Board of Elections on or prior to November 18th, 2024, and who shall have resided in the Town of Brownville Joint Fire District for at least 30 days preceding such election shall be qualified to vote.
